S.A.G.E.

(Sustainable Agriculture and Green Energy)

The S.A.G.E. program is a year long introductory course to Agriscience, which provides students with the foundational knowledge needed to succeed within the agricultural industry. Students are introduced to all seven of the primary agricultural pathways: Animal Systems, Plant Systems, Food Products & Processing Systems, Natural Resource Systems, Environmental Systems, and Agricultural Business Systems. By exploring each of the agricultural pathways, every student is given the opportunity to make informed choices about how they would like to specialize their agricultural education.



(Science Technology, Engineering and Math)

The purpose of the Englewood School District's STEM program is to foster an environment to support student acquisition and practice of the Colorado Department of Education's 21st century skills which are comprised of critical thinking and reasoning; information literacy; collaboration; self-direction; and invention. The program will actively engage students in practicing specific 21st century skills readiness and competencies for the content areas of Science; Math, Reading, Writing, and communication; Social Studies; and Visual Arts. CFHSC has State-of- the-Art STEM Labs.

Digital Audio Production Program

The digital audio production program offers students an opportunity to participate in the use of state-of-the art digital audio workstations where they manipulate sound waveforms for music and/or video production. Compositions are focused on student-honed creativity. Students will engage in the following: the foundations of musical theory (offered for *concurrent college credit through Arapahoe Community College*), the basic structure and techniques to compose their own EDM songs, basic miking, MIDI instruments and samples to record, edit and overdub. Students are encouraged to work collaboratively.



Fine Arts Program

We have an outstanding Fine Arts program that has won numerous awards including The Capitol Hill People's Fair Mural Project, The Sidewalk Art Festival Award, The First Congressional Art Competition Award and numerous pieces featured in the Englewood Art Calendar Contest. Our students work with a variety of mediums including: acrylics, oil and watercolor painting, clay sculpture, papier-mache' and life drawing. The art department collaborates with social studies and language arts teachers to offer multicultural classes. Students are also exposed to Denver's vibrant art scene through field trips to Colorado Ballet performances, plays and First Friday gallery exhibits.
